On behalf of our entire organization, we would like to thank you for a job well done supporting the emergency repair work at our Wheelabrator Shasta facility.

On April 28th, 2016 we experienced the worst turbine generator casualty in our company's history. The failure of our plant DC power system resulted in significant damage to all three turbine generator sets. Needless to say, this was not a typical outage which made the required repairs even more challenging. We completed three simultaneous overhauls/inspections with all three turbine rotors and all three generator rotors leaving the site for journal repairs. Considering this expansive scope, and the fact that we had never done an overhaul on more than one of these machines at any given time, the following total outage times are remarkable:
